### 2019 results

We are so proud again of our children and the results they achieved this year.

Pupils and staff have worked very hard. These assessments continue to highlight the importance of reading regularly at home with your child and exposing them to a broad a vocabulary as possible as this is often where our pupils struggle when compared to others.

#### **Foundation Stage**

Our Good Level of Development score remained at 69% which is slightly below LA and national but within 1 child or those percentages. This represents excellent progress from their starting points.

#### **Key Stage One**

The phonics screening test results were 73% passed. This a light decrease (-0.8%) on 2018. This is below local authority and national and an area we are working on to further improve but does not take their starting points into account. Please help us by working with your children on their phonics and reading lots and lots with your child.

Our Year 2 attainment scores are slightly below national for that cohort. They show a slight decline for reading and writing and a slight increase in maths.

#### **Key Stage Two SATs**

In KS2 the Year 6 cohort did an amazing job with the SATs tests.

Attainment in all subjects and at expected and higher standard are above national. This is the first time during my leadership of the school that this has happened.

It isn't just that that results are above national but that they are well above and put us in the top 5<sup>th</sup> of all schools in the county for most measures. For maths, we are the 11<sup>th</sup> best school in the county for higher standard and 28<sup>th</sup> best school at the expected standard. This is attainment only so doesn't take into account these children's starting points.

For maths progress we are the 14<sup>th</sup> best school within the authority (33<sup>rd</sup> for reading and 74<sup>th</sup> for writing). Reading progress was +2.7 and a significantly positive result. Writing progress was +1.5 and only narrowly off being a significantly positive result. Maths progress was +4.0 and a significantly positive result (almost off the graph!).

These figures show just what an amazing job the children and staff did last year.
