Reading books

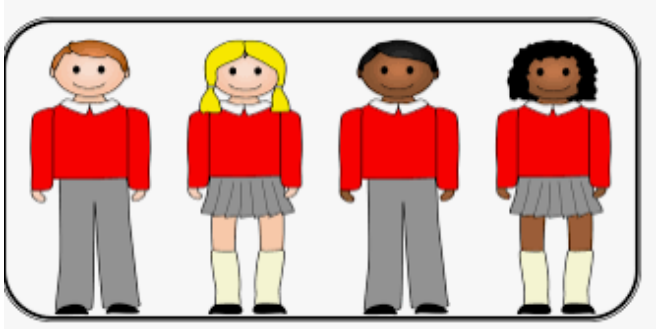
