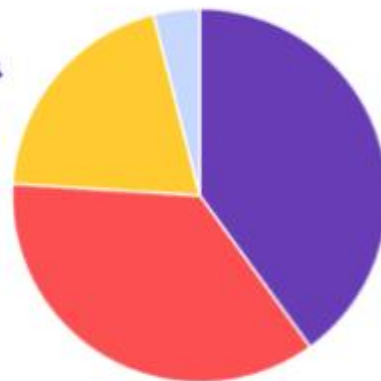
How it works...
