Congratulations to Orange class for a weekly attendance of 99.64%

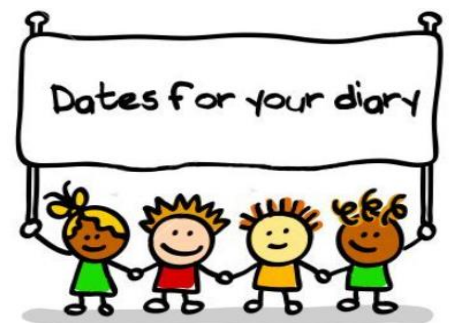
