Dear Parents/Carers,

The Government gives Pupil Premium money to schools to help eligible children to do their very best. For each child who is eligible for Pupil Premium funding the school receives £1320 which will be spent to provide a range of support strategies for these children. If you are eligible your child may also be able to have free school meals and milk until the end of Year 6.

If you are in receipt of any of these benefits below you should be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding.

You can register your child for Pupil Premium Funding if you get any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Registering is really quick and easy – if you think you qualify, call 0300 500 80 80 or register online at (where you will need to create an online account if you haven't already done so)
